PUBLIC NOTICE

The United States Congress (Congress) enacted the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018, Pub. L. 115-123 (Act), which required in Section 21210, that the Government of Puerto Rico develops an Economic and Disaster Recovery Plan (Recovery Plan) that must be submitted on August 8, 2018. Therefore, the Central Recovery and Reconstruction Office of Puerto Rico (COR3) has been developing the Recovery Plan in coordination with, but not limited to, the Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA), the Secretary of the Treasury, the Secretary of Energy, and other Federal agencies having responsibilities defined under the National Disaster Recovery Framework, the Governor of the of Puerto Rico, the Homeland Security Operational Analysis Center (HSOAC), and key stakeholders across Puerto Rico.

The purpose of the public notice is to inform that the draft Recovery Plan **will be available for the citizens on July 9, 2018 at www.p3.pr.gov**. Once published, it is expected to obtain comments and suggestions for how the Recovery Plan can be improved.
