Dear Members of the Partnership Committee,

In accordance with Article 8(b) of Act No. 29-2009, as amended, known as the Public Private Partnerships Act (“Act 29”) and Section 3.4 of *Regulation for the Procurement, Evaluation, Selection, Negotiation and Award of Partnership Contracts and Sale Contracts for The Transformation of the Electric System Under Act No. 120-2018, as Amended* (the “Regulation”), the Puerto Rico Public Private Partnerships Authority (the “Authority”) hereby submits for your consideration a request to approve the revised timeline summarizing certain key milestones in the process of the Request for Proposals for Puerto Rico Electric Power Transmission and Distribution System RFP 2019-2 (“RFP”) approved by the Partnership Committee (the “PC”) on February 1, 2019.

For your benefit, the Authority includes the revised timeline below showing the revisions made to the previous timeline included as part of Addendum No. 3 to the RFP.

Distribution of definitive evaluation criteria for Binding Proposals	Expected early Augu
Qualified Respondents provide comments to revised draft of O&M Agreement	Expected end of Augu
O&M Agreement discussions with Qualified Respondents (if needed)	N/A
Distribution of final form of O&M Agreement	Expected mid-Septem
Distribution of definitive submission instructions under Section 4.3 of the RFP for Binding Proposals	Expected early Augu
Binding Proposal submission deadline	Expected mid-October

If approved by the Members of the PC, the revised timeline will be circulated to the proponents as part of Addendum No. 4 (included herein) to the RFP.

To that effect, the Authority respectfully requests the Members of the PC to, in the exercise of their responsibilities under Act 29 and the Regulation, approve Addendum No. 4 (included herein) to the RFP. Unanimous written consent from all Members of the PC is required to approve this Addendum No. 4.
